



# Poster Competition Information and Entry Criteria

The National Water Week Poster Competition is on again! Primary School students are asked to create a poster reflecting water related issues which are important and relevant to them and their local area.

Poster entries are invited in four categories:

1. Prep / Foundation
2. Years 1 & 2
3. Years 3 & 4
4. Years 5 & 6

Great prizes can be won by the student and the school at both local AND state level judging.

**Teachers** – this is a great activity for the classroom in the lead up to National Water Week. Last year '000s of poster entries were received from Victorian Primary Schools.

- At *state level* cash prizes are available to the school that the first-place and second-place posters from each of the categories (**\$300** for 1<sup>st</sup> and **\$150** for 2<sup>nd</sup>).

**Students** - entries will be judged locally with winners in each category submitted for state judging.

- At *state level* cash prizes are available to the students that produce the first-place and second-place posters in each of the categories (**\$500** for 1<sup>st</sup> and **\$250** for 2<sup>nd</sup>).

**Central Highlands Water's first prize for each category is a \$250 bike voucher.**

### Winners will be chosen using the following criteria:

- How well the poster conveys water related issues relevant to your area ie; inland school posters would not be focussed on ocean activities.
- How well it can be reproduced to promote National Water Week.
- Appearance: attractively displayed in colour.
- How good it looks from a distance
- Effective use of art materials.
- Originality of design or innovative concept.
- One entry per student.
- One student per poster.

### Entry criteria

- **Poster MUST be A3 (30x40cm) in size**
- **Any** medium, including paper, can be used.
- **Any** art material can be used including paint, textas, coloured pencils or collage materials.
- An official entry form **must** be securely attached to the back of each poster.
- Entries must reach Central Highlands Water by Friday 31 August 2018.
