

MAJOR PROJECTS

On behalf of our customers we operate and maintain over \$900 million of assets across 15 water supply systems and 12 wastewater systems throughout the region.

Our assets include:

- 2,416km of water mains
- 1,271km of sewer mains
- 15 water treatment plants
- 10 sewerage treatment plants
- 53 water pumping stations
- 95 sewer pumping stations
- 31 reservoirs
- 13 diversion weirs
- 32 groundwater bores

During their lifespan many of these assets will need to be replaced or upgraded to ensure continued service reliability, meet the needs of growth areas and comply with improved regulatory requirements.

CAPITAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM

We propose to spend \$100 million on major capital works projects during the Water Plan 2013-2018 period including:

- Maryborough water quality improvement project
- Major upgrade of the Ballarat South Wastewater Treatment Plant
- Renewing and replacing ageing water and/or sewer mains in Avoca, Ballarat, Clunes, Daylesford, Dean, Forrest Hill and Maryborough
- Reservoir and dam works in Avoca, Ballarat, Daylesford, Landsborough, Lexton, Redbank and Talbot
- Completing four country town sewer systems
- Pump station upgrades

This \$100 million investment will ensure customers continue to have access to secure and reliable water and sewerage services (where provided) and new and growing areas can access water and sewerage services.
