THE UNFLUSHABLES

THE IMPACT



Incorrect waste can attach to fatty build-ups in our pipes causing blockages.



Plastics in products can remain in ecosystems for a very long time, damaging the environment.



Clearing blockages costs around \$100,000 a year, ultimately adding costs onto bills.
